Wilderness Fishing Oasis



Wilderness Fishing Oasis is your fly-in destination for trophy Muskie, Walleye, Bass, Northern Pike and Lake Trout fishing located in beautiful Nestor Falls, Ontario.

Wilderness Fishing Oasis is a fly-in remote fishing camp located on an island in Rowan Lake. The lake is approximately 60,000 acres (about 17 miles long and 7 miles wide) with over 60 islands. The deepest part of the lake is about 180 feet. The lake structure, clear water, plentiful bait fish and vegetation supports an abundance of healthy world class trophy Muskie Lake Trout, Walleye, Northern and Bass. Rowan lake offers open water and protection by islands and shoreline for all day fishing even on the windiest days.

Wilderness Fishing Oasis has three cabins with full bath and two with separate assigned bath houses with toilets and showers. Each cabin has a full kitchen with new appliances and cookware and utensils. Every cabin has a BBQ and an indoor woodstove. Daily housekeeping service is provided with fresh towels and linens for all cabins. There is a main firepit any for everyone to share. The lodge has a dining room with fresh coffee and breakfast served

daily. There is also a sauna for guests to use.

All rates include lodging, new 16-foot Alumacraft boat with flat bottom, new 15 or 20 HP Suzuki electric start motor and gas. Breakfast is served daily at the lodge and is included in your rate. You are responsible for your own lunch and dinner.

All packages include required flight from Nestor Falls, ON.

Weight allowance for cargo on the plane is 80lbs. per person. Only pack what you need. **Over packing may result in extra charges that will NOT be included in your rate.**
